Governor Link visits

As part of their projects and general duties the school Governors undertake various visits to the school. Recent Governor visits have taken place for the following reasons:

The school held a Governors open day on the 26th February where there was a forum for the school staff to talk to the Governors and for the Governors to meet with the pupils. The Governors also assisted within some of the lessons to interact with the pupils and teachers and get first-hand experience of how the school delivers the curriculum.

The Governors attended a school review inspection on the 26th January where they were challenged on the day to day operation of the school and its performance by an Ofsted inspector.

The Governing body also undertook training on the 8th March for the preparation for an Ofsted inspection.
