Cycling to School Policy

This policy has been written by children from the School Council (Class 1 to Class 6 Councillors)

Below are statements outlining the use of bicycles by children, and/or adults while on school property.

- A child should only cycle to school if they have a Level 2 Cycling Proficiency certificate and their parents' permission.
- Anyone riding a bike to school must wear a helmet, correctly fastened.
- Bicycles should not be ridden in the school grounds (get off outside the gate and walk.)
- Use the cycle racks for bikes only.
- Ride safely.
- Bikes must be locked and all equipment is left at the cycle racks at the owner's risk. (Any loss, damage or theft is not the responsibility of the school.)
